## Children's Mental Health Week



Next week is Place2Be's Children's Mental Health Week. To mark the week and support the children in developing their understanding of mental health and the different ways they can look after their own mental health and wellbeing, we will be taking part in a series of activities throughout the week. Some of these activities will allow the children to try something new and will highlight the positive link between mental health and physical activity.

Place2Be have partnered with Disney and this year's theme of 'Know yourself, Grow yourself' has been inspired by the 'Inside Out' films.
