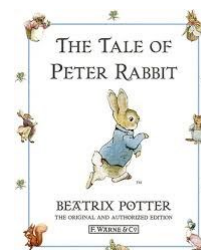
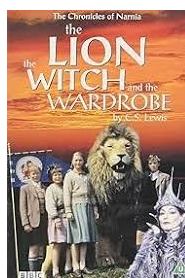
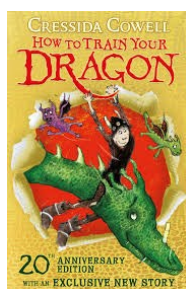
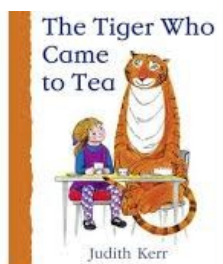
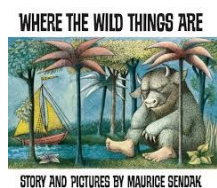
World Book Day

This year, World Book Day is on the 6th March. We will be celebrating our love of books and reading throughout the week, but have decided that the main focus of our celebrations (and the day we will dress up!) will be on Wednesday 5th March.
