## Consultation Dates: 17<sup>th</sup> December – 21<sup>st</sup> January

#### For the attention of all stakeholders:

The Governing Body of Twiss Green Community Primary School is seeking the views of stakeholders on a proposal to permanently change the age range of the school from 4-11 years to 3-11 years, to enable the school to run a pre-school class. This document is part of a five-week consultation process which opens on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2024 and closes on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2025. At the end of the consultation period, a decision will be taken by the Governing Body on whether to proceed with the proposed change of age range.

### What change is being proposed?

Twiss Green Community Primary School currently provides early years education for children who turn five when in our Reception class. The proposed pre-school provision at Twiss Green will accommodate a maximum of 24 children per session and will use a spare classroom at its location. The provision would operate under the school's Ofsted registration and provide spaces for three and four year olds.

Please note that if this proposed change of age range to the school goes ahead, it will not affect the determined admissions process for entry into the Reception year. Parents will still need to follow the school admission process and apply for a place for their child in Reception, even if he/she attends the pre-school.

This consultation closes on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2025. A report summarising the responses received will be submitted to the governing body and a final decision will be made about whether or not to proceed by the end of the spring term. If a decision is made to go ahead, the provision will open in September 2025.
